RECOMMENDED COURSES FOR MAJORS PLANNING TO TRANSFER TO VWU

Students planning to transfer to Virginia Wesleyan University from anywhere within the Virginia Community College System (VCCS) should take credit for a maximum of 60 credits for VCCS courses in order to ensure timely degree completion. Courses in black are strongly recommended—students who do not complete these courses may require an additional year due to course sequencing issues. Courses in blue are encouraged—there are no restrictions on transfer credit for these courses. **Students who complete the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will satisfy all of the VWU general education program except for the junior/senior seminar (WES 300).**

COURSE SEQUENCING: HIST 111 AND HIST 122 MUST BE TAKEN IN SEQUENCE WITH WESTERN HISTORY

Transfer credit for HIST 111 and HIST 122 is only granted if the student earned a grade of "C" or better.
